Youth Recreational Scholarship Program (YRSP)

Who Can Use the Program

Access to discounts for household with the ability to engage in a full range of events and activities.

Des Moines Public School students have access to youth sports and swim lessons.

Qualification Criteria

Total income based on number in household. Must be a Des Moines Resident.

2 - \$41,150

3 - \$51,950

4 - \$62,750

5 - \$73,550

6 - \$84,350

Active Des Moines Public Schools students enrolled in the Free and Reduce Meal Program.

Eligibility Verification

Verification of total income through IMPACT Community Action Partnership using approved list of documents (i.e. paycheck, taxes, etc.). Call 518-4770 to set up an appointment with IMPACT at one of their two locations.

Electronic opt-in process through [Des Moines Public Schools website](#) (Search = Scholarship). To opt-in, click on the [link](#). This program will be promoted during the enrollment period each school year. Opting in can be done at any time throughout the school year through the DMPS website.

Registration Process

Once a community member receives their GRASP card from IMPACT Community Action Partnership, they can contact the Des Moines Parks and Recreation Administration Office to activate discounts for registration through CivicRec.
