ORDINANCE O.2278-2026

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON
AUTHORIZING THE VACATION OF A CERTAIN PORTION
OF THOMAS PLACE PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40:67-1**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:67-1 permits the governing body of every municipality to make, amend, repeal and enforce ordinances to vacate any portion of any public street, highway, lane, alley, square, place, or park, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Place is a municipal right-of-way in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that vacation of a portion of Thomas Place, as indicated on the map and as described in the metes and bounds description, both of which are on file in the Township Clerk's Office, would be in the best interests of the community, provided that all rights and privileges possessed by public utilities, as defined in N.J.S.A. 48:2-13, and by any cable television company, as defined in the Cable Television Act, N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1, et seq., to maintain, repair and replace their existing facilities in, adjacent to, over or under the street to be vacated, are expressly reserved and excepted from the vacation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON, IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

Section 2. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:67-1, et seq., the Township Council hereby vacates the portion of Thomas Place as indicated on the map as described in the metes and bounds description, both of which are on file in the Township

Clerk's Office, subject to minor adjustments that may be required based on approval of final site plans by the Planning Board, and releases such property from the dedication of the land for a public street and extinguishes the public right arising from such dedication; provided however, that all rights and privileges possessed by public utilities, as defined in N.J.S.A. 48:2-13, and by any cable television company, as defined in the Cable Television Act, N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1, et seq., to maintain, repair and replace their existing facilities in, adjacent to, over or under the street to be vacated, are expressly reserved and excepted from the vacation.

Section 3. The vacated roadways from the centerline hereby transfers to the adjoining properties by operation of law.

Section 4. The introduction of this Ordinance shall be advertised pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-2; provided, however, that notice as to introduction and public hearing shall be made, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-6, at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing and adoption hereof.

Section 5. Notice of the introduction of this ordinance and the time and place when and where this Ordinance will be further considered for public hearing and final passage, including a copy of this ordinance, shall be mailed to every person whose lands may be affected by this ordinance, so far as same may be ascertained, directed to the last known post-office address, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:49-6.

Section 6. Within sixty (60) days after adoption of this Ordinance, the Township Clerk shall cause this ordinance, certified under the seal of the Township, to be filed in the office wherein conveyances of lands are recorded in the County of Middlesex, and the Township Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be re-recorded to amend the map

and metes and bounds description hereto as necessary to address those minor adjustments that may be required based on approval of final site plans by the Planning Board, as set forth in Paragraph 2 above.

Section 7. If any part(s) of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid, such part(s) shall be severed and the invalidity thereby shall not affect the remaining parts of this ordinance.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON TO EXECUTE RIGHT-OF-ENTRY AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY, TO ENTER IN, ON, OVER AND ACROSS THE LAND DESCRIBED AS RARITAN CENTER PARKWAY AND CLOVER PLACE RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING INVESTIGATIVE MONITORING PHASE ACTIVITES.

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (hereinafter referred to as “Township”) is a municipal corporation in the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America, Department of the Army (hereinafter referred to as “Government”) would like to access land located in Edison known as APN 1205_390.04_17, 205 Raritan Center Parkway and Clover Place right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to grant to the Government, its employees, officers and contractors, a right to enter in, on, and across the land described above, for the purpose of conducting investigative phase activities including the right to construct, operate, maintain, alter, repair and remove groundwater monitoring wells and appurtenances thereto for the monitoring of contamination in groundwater; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Township to permit the Government to have a Right-of-Entry for monitoring contaminated groundwater; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Township of Edison hereby authorizes the execution of the Department of the Army Right-of-Entry Agreement in substantially the form annexed hereto and made a part of hereof.
2. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk are authorized to execute any and all agreements with the United States of America, Department of the Army (USACE) including any other applicable exhibits or forms related hereto, such changes as shall be approved on the advice of Township Counsel.

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector of the Township of Edison, Lorraine Morris, reports and advises that at various sales of land for delinquent taxes held by the Edison Township Collector of Taxes, Middlesex County, New Jersey, the attached listing of tax sale certificates were sold; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector further reports that the said tax sale certificates have been redeemed thereof, and further advises that the purchasers of said property are legally entitled to a refund of monies paid at the time of redemption.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, that the aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

RESOLUTION

Authorizing Cancellation and Refund of Taxes for Exempted Disabled Veteran

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, the dwelling of a disabled veteran shall be exempt from real property taxes; and

WHEREAS, Attached listing includes veterans who have been determined to have suffered a 100% service-related disability, with the determination of said disability being retroactive to the indicated effective date; and their respective owned properties, identified with their block, lot and qualifier, were already billed for indicated tax year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32, the governing body of a municipality may cancel by resolution taxes due on a property which would have been exempt had the claim been made at the time they were due; and

WHEREAS, as permitted by N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32, Township Code Section 5-7(d) also authorizes the return of property taxes for the current year and prior year but not greater than for a twenty-four (24) month period in the aggregate, or, should the Veteran's Administration determine that a veteran's disability date is greater than twenty-four (24) months from the date the applicant submits his/her application with the Tax Assessor's office, the Township will only be obligated to return taxes for a period of no greater than twenty-four (24) months from receipt of a completed application to the Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Township Code Section 5-7(d) the listed applicants are also due a refund of property taxes paid from the effective date of the determination; and the Tax Collector has reviewed the applications, approvals and taxes paid and recommends that the listed applicants are entitled to receive refund of paid taxes in the amount indicated on the attached list.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, that the aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Edison that property taxes due and assessed as specified on the attached list be cancelled for the indicated quarters, tax years and amounts, and also refunded for the municipal property taxes already paid from the effective date; and

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON TO TRANSFER TO THE EDISON PUBLIC LIBRARY \$375,000.00 IN REIMBURSEMENT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NJ STATE LIBRARIAN FOR THE EXPANSION AND RENOVATION OF THE NORTH EDISON BRANCH LIBRARY

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (the “Township”) is a municipal corporation in the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Edison Public Library (the “Library”) is a free public library established under N.J.S.A. 40:54-1, *et. seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the NJ State Legislature approved an appropriation in the amount of \$1,500,000.00 in grant funding to finance eligible expenses for library construction projects as defined under the NJ Library Construction Bond Act; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2022, the Township Council enacted Resolution R.408-062022 which authorized the Edison Public Library to execute and deliver a grant agreement with the New Jersey State Librarian for the expansion and renovation of the North Edison Branch Library (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, at the time of execution of the grant agreement, the Library used the Township’s budget accounting system; and

WHEREAS, the Township recently received a reimbursement of \$375,000.00 in grant funding related to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Library now has its own budget accounting system and the \$375,000.00 in grant funds must be transferred from the Township to the Library.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey that the Administration is hereby authorized to transfer the reimbursement of \$375,000.00 in grant funds from the NJ State Librarian for the expansion and renovation of the North Edison Branch Library.
