ORDINANCE O.2279-2026

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5-5, "SPORTS ORGANIZATION FUNDING," OF CHAPTER 5, "REVENUE AND FINANCE," OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON TO MODIFY...

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (hereinafter the "Township") is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend Section 5-5 entitled, "Sports Organization Funding," of Chapter 5 entitled, "Revenue and Finance," by modifying the law around the funding of sports organizations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Edison, County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 5 entitled "Revenue and Finance," is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I

Chapter 5. Revenue and Finance

§ 5-5. YOUTH SPORTS ORGANIZATION FUNDING.

§ 5-5.1. Definitions.

As used in this section:

EDISON RESIDENT

Means an individual whose primary residence is within the Township of Edison.

MINOR

Means an individual under the age of eighteen (18) years.

SPORTS ORGANIZATION

Means those organizations established pursuant to the not-for-profit laws of the State of New Jersey for the purpose of promoting a particular sport for its participants, whether child, teenager or adult. ~~Specifically, the following shall constitute the "sports organizations" under this section:~~

- ~~b. Edison Angels;~~

- ~~c. Edison Boys Baseball;~~
- ~~d. Edison Jets;~~
- ~~e. Edison Youth Basketball;~~
- ~~f. Father and Son American Legion No. 435;~~
- ~~g. Fords/Clara Barton Little League;~~
- ~~h. Fords/Clara Barton Soccer League;~~
- ~~i. Light Towers Wrestling;~~
- ~~j. Metuchen/Edison Soccer;~~
- ~~k. Little Eagles Wrestling;~~

- ~~n. North Edison Shamrocks;~~
- ~~o. Edison Buddy Ball.~~

YOUTH SPORTS

Means organized or recreational athletic activities for children and adolescents under age 18 which is intended to foster physical, social, and mental development.

§ 5-5.2. Intent.

The ~~S~~ports organizations ~~identified in subsection 5-5.1~~ promote the public health and welfare of their participants and provide an outlet for such participants which would not otherwise be available without such sports organizations. It is, therefore, in the best interest of the Township to provide financial support for said sports organizations. This section is enacted pursuant to necessary and proper authority of municipalities set forth in N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.

§ 5-5.3. Donations.

- a. The Township may, at its discretion, include within the budget for Township of Edison Recreation Department monies for the purpose of making donations to eligible youth sports organizations in accordance with this Ordinance.**
- b. Eligibility: To be eligible to receive a Donation under this Ordinance, an applicant organization shall:**
 - 1. Demonstrate that at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the participating athletes are Edison Residents who are minors by providing a current participant roster identifying each participant's age and residency, together with a certification executed by an authorized officer of the organization attesting to the accuracy of the roster and the organization's compliance with the seventy-five percent (75%) residency/minor requirement; and**
 - 2. Provide documentation evidencing the organization's not-for-profit status in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey; and**

3. Be in good standing with the Township with respect to any prior Township agreements, permits, field use authorizations, or prior donations, if applicable; and
 4. Provide a detailed budget for the season or program period for which the Donation is sought, identifying intended uses of Township funds;
- c. Award: Donations may be awarded in such amounts and on such terms as the Township Administration (or its authorized designee) determines to be in the best interests of the Township, subject to available appropriations.
1. Donations shall be used solely for youth sports purposes as approved by Administration and shall not be used for purposes inconsistent with approval.
 2. The may require repayment to the Township of any funds not used in accordance with the approval.

Any and all Township donations to the sports organizations identified in subsection 5-5.1 shall be made by and through the budget of the Department of Parks and Recreation. Commencing in calendar year 1993 and continuing each year thereafter, donations to sports organizations shall be based upon a formula to be established by resolution of the Township Council and implemented by the Department of Administration and the Department of Parks and Recreation. Such formula shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following criteria:

- a. ~~Types of playing fields;~~
- b. ~~Field lighting;~~
- c. ~~Liability insurance;~~
- d. ~~Sports equipment;~~
- e. ~~Umpire fees;~~
- f. ~~Utilities;~~
- g. ~~Uniforms.~~

§ 5-5.4. Regulations; Contract Required.

The Department of Township Administration, in concert with the Department of Parks and Recreation, shall have the right to promulgate such regulations as are necessary to effectuate this chapter. Specifically, the Department of Administration and the Department of Parks and Recreation shall, As a condition precedent to the receipt by any sports organization of any Township funds, the sports organization shall to execute a contract with the Township to ensure that the funds donated are being used for the intended purpose. The contract with the sports organization shall be in such form as approved by the Department of Law and the Business Administrator, **and shall include the following:**

- a. Purpose: Include a detailed budget for the season or program period for which the Donation is sought, identifying intended uses of Township funds.
- b. Insurance Coverage: Insurance coverage in the types and minimum limits specified by the Township which may include (as applicable) commercial general liability, automobile liability (if vehicles are used), workers' compensation/employers' liability (if applicable), and accident/participant medical coverage. The Township of Edison, its officers, employees, and agents must be named as additional insureds on the organization's liability policies, as specified by the Township.
- c. Indemnification and Hold Harmless: The Organization must agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Township of Edison, its officers, employees, and agents from and against claims, damages, losses, and expenses arising out of or relating to the organization's operations, activities, use of Township facilities (if any), or receipt/use of the Donation, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- d. Financial Disclosure: The Agreement shall require the organization to provide financial documents sufficient to demonstrate appropriate use of Township funds, which may include annual financial statements, season/program budgets, general ledgers, bank statements, and not-for-profit informational returns, as specified by the Township. The Agreement shall also require the organization to retain Donation-related records for a period specified by the Township and to certify compliance upon request.
- e. Termination: If the Township determines that an organization has made a material misrepresentation in its application or has failed to comply with this Ordinance or the Agreement, the Township may suspend or terminate eligibility, withhold or discontinue disbursements, require repayment as provided in the Agreement, and pursue any other remedies available at law or in equity.

§ 5-5.5. Roster and Financial Disclosure by Sports Organizations Receiving Funds From the Township.

- a. All sports organizations which receive appropriations in any calendar year from the Township in exchange for the rendering of service to the community shall be required to file a profit and loss statement and a balance sheet with the Township Administration Director of Parks and Recreation. The filed documents shall be certified by the executive officer of the sports organization, shall be prepared based upon sound acceptable accounting methods, as determined by the Township Director of Finance, and shall reflect the cash flow of the organization. All such documents shall be filed annually, on or before March 31st, unless the sports organization shall obtain an extension of time from the Director of Recreation for good cause, such extension not to exceed sixty (60)

days. Good cause shown shall include difficulties in preparing required documents due to a newly formed sports organization, difficulty preparing documents based upon the sports organization's fiscal year and similar considerations. If any sports organization required to comply with this paragraph and paragraph b. below shall fail to comply with either of these subsections, the Township Council, upon receiving advice from the Director of Recreation, may withhold payments of the appropriation for the current and subsequent years.

- b. Contemporaneous with the filing of the profit and loss statement required by paragraph a., the Department of Recreation shall certify the number of participants contained on their roster broken down by Edison residents and nonresidents. An accurate roster shall at all times be maintained by the sports organization and shall be subject to, at any time, inspection by the Department Recreation.

SECTION II

SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III

REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION IV

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon this passage and publication in accordance with the law.

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2025, the Township filed a Declaratory Judgment action seeking a judicial determination of the Township’s fair share obligation for the Fourth Round, review of a Housing Element and Fair Share Plan addressing that obligation, and, ultimately, a Judgment of Compliance and Repose providing immunity from exclusionary zoning litigation for the Fourth Round period ending in 2035; and

WHEREAS, the Court entered an Order setting the Township’s fair share obligation for the Fourth Round and requiring that the Township submit a duly adopted Housing Element and Fair Share Plan by April 15, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Township’s professionals have prepared a Housing Element and Fair Share Plan for the Fourth Round (the “HEFSP”), which identifies the Township’s proposed compliance structure; and

WHEREAS, the HEFSP was adopted by the Planning Board on March 30, 2026, and the Township Council has reviewed and now wishes to endorse the HEFSP and to authorize submission of the HEFSP to the Court for review.
