All fees include \$65 administrative fee.		

All Soil Erosion Permits will be issued for either a 1-year or 2-year period, depending on the fees paid at the time the permit application is submitted. Once the permit has expired, a new permit will be required. If the project is not complete and soils are not stabilized, a new permit fee will be charged upon date of expiration.

Resource mining fees (New or expired for over 2 years – 1 year permit):	
10 acres or less	\$325
>10 - 20 acres	\$400
>20 - 30 acres	\$480
>30 - 40 acres	\$560
>40 - 50 acres	\$640
Resource mining 5- year renewal fee:	\$600

Late Fee:

Late fees will be double the initial cost for work started prior to obtaining the permit.
