FOOD TRUCK ORDINANCE

Discussion was held regarding proposed Ordinance 08-17-21-D providing for and regulating Food Trucks in the City of Enterprise. Following discussion, it was the consensus of the Council to table the ordinance until September 21 to allow time for revisions based on public feedback and Council recommendations.

BUSINESS LICENSE ORDINANCE

Discussion was held regarding proposed Ordinance 08-17-21-C providing for the implementation of a new business license code and schedule for the City of Enterprise as of January 1, 2022, and thereafter. Following discussion, it was the consensus of the Council to table the ordinance until September 21 to allow time for revisions based on public feedback and staff recommendations.

STREET RESURFACING UPDATE – Barry Mott & Glenn Morgan


Final plans for Phase II of the city's resurfacing project will be reviewed next week, with advertising for bids expected on September 22. The project is estimated to include 17.5 miles of resurfacing on streets with a PCI (Pavement Condition Index) rating of 20 or less and a low risk of utility issues.
