AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE, 2009 EDITION WITH APPENDICES WITHOUT SETTING OUT SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AT LENGTH IN THE CODE, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

WHEREAS: As provided by Title 11-45-8, Code of Alabama of 1975, as amended, the City Council of the City of Enterprise, Alabama, did on January 21, 2014, adopt Resolution 01-21-14, which declared a public hearing to be held on Tuesday, February 18, 2014 at 6:00 p.m., in the City Council Chamber at City Hall, Enterprise, Alabama, to determine whether or not the Governing Body of said City shall pass an ordinance adopting by reference thereto, without setting the same out at length in the ordinance, rules and regulations governing standards for the construction, alteration, repair or removal of buildings and structures in the City of Enterprise, Alabama, which regulations have been printed in a code in book or pamphlet form, and is called the International Mechanical Code, 2009 Edition with appendices; and

WHEREAS: At least fifteen days notice of the time, place and purpose of such hearing was given by publication of the Resolution once a week for two successive weeks in the Enterprise Ledger, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Enterprise, Alabama, in the issues of said newspaper under dates of January 26, 2014 and February 2, 2014 and;

WHEREAS: At least three copies of such code were filed for not less than fifteen days prior to the holding of the public hearing for use and examination by the public at the Office of the City Clerk, with public notice given to that effect; and

WHEREAS: Said public hearing was held at the time and place set out in said Resolution, and no one appeared and offered any objections or exceptions to the adoption of said Code by reference thereto:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENTERPRISE, ALABAMA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the International Mechanical Code, 2009 Edition with appendices, which provides rules and regulations governing mechanical standards in the City of Enterprise is hereby adopted as the Mechanical Code of the City of Enterprise, Alabama.

SECTION 2. That the rules and regulations set out in said International Mechanical Code, 2009 Edition with appendices be and the same are declared, determined and ordered to be the rules and regulations governing mechanical standards in the City of Enterprise, Alabama, without setting out such rules and regulations at length in this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. That the violation of any of the rules and regulations set out in said International Mechanical Code, 2009 Edition with appendices be and the same are hereby declared to be a misdemeanor, and any person, firm or association adjudged guilty of the violation of such rules and regulations shall be fined not exceeding one hundred dollars;

SECTION 4. On the effective date of this Ordinance, all other local Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance, and all amendments thereto, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.
