

## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM CERTIFIED PROJECT OF SECZETTA, INC.

WHEREAS, SECZETTA, Inc. has submitted an Economic Development Incentive Program (EDIP) Application to the City of Fall River and is seeking Certified Project Status under the Massachusetts Economic Development Incentive Program created by Chapter 23A of the Massachusetts General Laws; Chapter 166 of the Acts of 2009 and 402 CMR 2.00, and

WHEREAS, the City of Fall River has been designated a gateway municipality by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and SECZETTA, Inc. plans to relocate its headquarters from Rhode Island, invest in equipment and create 93 full-time permanent jobs over the terms of its TIF Agreement with the City, and

WHEREAS, SECZETTA, Inc. is seeking a Personal Property Tax Increment Financing Agreement of the Certified Project approval and meets the minimum requirements of and the project described in the Economic Assistance Coordinating Council Certified Project Application under M.G.L. c. 40, Section 59, M.G.L. c. 59, Section 5, and M.G.L. c. 23A, Sections 3E and 3F, and the applicable regulations thereunder, and

WHEREAS, the proposed Tax Incentive Certified Project is located at 1082 Davol Street, Fall River, Massachusetts, which is within the boundaries of the gateway municipality of Fall River, and the Greater Fall River Economic Target Area, and

WHEREAS, approval of the SECZETTA, Inc. Economic Assistance Coordinating Council Certified Project Application in accordance with the above referenced laws, rules and regulations of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is hereby accepted by the City Council, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Fall River hereby approves and endorses the proposed Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Agreement, which is limited to a personal property exemption pursuant to M.G.L. c. 40, Section 59, M.G.L. c. 59, Section 5, and M.G.L. c. 23A, Sections 3C(a) and (b), 3E and 3F, and the applicable regulations thereunder, between the City of Fall River and SecZetta, Inc. for the personal property to be located at 1082 Davol Street, Fall River, MA under the terms and conditions of the Tax Increment Agreement executed between the parties for same, and authorizes the Acting Mayor to execute the TIF Agreement, and any documents relating thereto and to take such other actions as necessary or appropriate to implement the TIF Agreement and such documents; and further authorizes the Acting Mayor to submit the Certified Project Application to the Massachusetts Economic Assistance Coordinating Council in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 23A, Sections 3(A) and 3(C), and finally authorizes the Acting Mayor or Mayor to take such other and further action as may be necessary or appropriate to carry out the TIF Plan as it relates to the project as described by the TIF Agreement and the purposes of this vote.

TAX INCREMENT FINANCING AGREEMENT  
(the "Agreement")

Between

City of Fall River, Massachusetts  
(the "City")

And

SecZetta, Inc.  
(the "Company")

This AGREEMENT is made as of this \_\_\_\_\_ day of November, 2019 by and between the City and the Company.

WHEREAS, the Company is a Rhode Island corporation having its current principal office at 221 3rd Street, Newport, RI, and is authorized to do business in Massachusetts; and

WHEREAS, the City is a Massachusetts municipal corporation acting through its City Council, having its principal office at One Government Center, Fall River, MA; and

WHEREAS, the Company wishes to relocate its primary operations relating to "non-employee identity risk solutions: create, control and respond to third party identity requirements and processes, and meet compliance and minimize data breaches" to Fall River and lease commercial office space at 1082 Davol Street, Fall River (hereinafter referred to as "the property"); and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to grant local tax exemptions for the Company's personal property in return for the Company to locate in the City, make capital investments in the property and primarily in equipment, and to create full-time permanent jobs during the term of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Company plans to relocate 23 permanent, full-time jobs upon moving to Fall River and create another 70 permanent full-time jobs over the term of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Company plans to invest approximately \$ 155,000.00 in construction costs and approximately \$340,000 in personal property over 5 years from the date of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Property is located within the boundaries of Greater Fall River Economic Target Area (ETA); and;

WHEREAS, the Company intends to apply for status as a Certified Project under the Massachusetts Economic Development Incentive Program (EDIP) as defined under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 23A, Section 3A, and 4.02 CMR 2.00; and

WHEREAS, the City strongly supports increased economic development to provide additional jobs, expand business within the City, and to develop a healthy economy and stronger tax base; and

WHEREAS on \_\_\_\_\_, 2019, the Fall River TIF Committee recommended approval of this TIF Agreement to City Council; and

WHEREAS on \_\_\_\_\_, 2019, the Fall River City Council voted to approve this Agreement.

Now, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereby agree as follows:

**A. THE CITY'S OBLIGATIONS**

1. A Personal Property Tax Exemption (the "Exemption") is hereby granted to the Company by the City in accordance with Chapter 23A, Section 3E; Chapter 40, Section 59, and Chapter 59, Section 5, Clause Fifty-first of the Massachusetts General Laws and the applicable regulations. The Exemption shall be for a period of five (5) years (the "Exemption Term"), commencing in fiscal year 2021, and shall provide an exemption from taxation of all taxable personal property situated at the Project during the term of this Agreement as follows and shown in Exhibit 1:

Year 1	100	%
Year 2	90	%
Year 3	80	%
Year 4	70	%
Year 5	60	%

2. The City hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute this Agreement on the City's behalf, and to monitor and enforce compliance by the Company with the terms of this Agreement. The Mayor is authorized to act for and on behalf of the City in proceedings relating to the approval of this Agreement by the Massachusetts Economic Assistance Coordinating Council.

## B. THE COMPANY'S OBLIGATIONS

The City grants the Exemption to the Company in consideration of and commitment by the Company of the following:

1. The Company shall relocate its operations to the City of Fall River on or before March 30, 2020. On or before March 30, 2020, the Company shall file a Form of List (State Tax Form 2-Return of personal property subject to taxation - General Laws Chapter 59, § 29) setting forth in detail all personal property subject to taxation that situated on the Property on the date the Company commences business operations in the City. The assessed valuation of said personal property, as determined by the Fall River Board of Assessors shall be deemed the actual initial investment made by the Company pursuant to this Agreement. The Company shall subsequently file a State Tax Form 2 by March 1 of each year during the term of the Agreement setting forth in detail all personal property subject to taxation that situated on the Property.
2. The Company shall create and retain 93 permanent full-time jobs during the term of this Agreement. The Company's job retention and creation plans are outlined in the Employment & Job Creation section of the EDIP Preliminary and Supplemental Applications submitted to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts by the Company in connection with the Company's request for a Personal Property Tax Exemption (which documents are incorporated herein by reference).
3. The Company shall submit an annual report to the Massachusetts Economic Assistance Coordinating Council ("EACC") through the Commonwealth's on-line portal for each year during the term of the Agreement. The annual report shall include the number of jobs retained and created, and value of the Property capital investments and other related items with respect to the Property annually and on a cumulative basis. The Company shall also submit a report as required by General Laws Chapter 40, Section 59(viii) to the Town Clerk and EACC.
4. The Company shall submit quarterly reports to the City of Fall River Mayor's Office, beginning with the First Quarter of Calendar Year 2020 and thereafter until the end of this Agreement, to include: employment levels at the beginning and end of the reporting period; the number of Fall River residents employed, and any other reasonable and relevant job creation information requested by and on a form provided to the Company by the City. The Company agrees to submit said report to the City no less than 30 days after each quarter.
5. If the Company fails to meet the obligations specified in this Section, the City, acting by its Mayor, may take action to notify the EACC and/or request decertification of the Project by the EACC. Upon decertification, the City shall discontinue the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) benefits provided to the Company, commencing with the first fiscal year in which the Project is decertified, or if such benefits have already been received by the Company for the fiscal year in which the Project has been decertified, commencing as of the fiscal year immediately following that fiscal year. Upon decertification, the City shall have authority to exercise the recapture provisions as set forth in Paragraph B.7, hereof.
6. Prior to taking any action to request decertification of the Project by the EACC, or upon the City's determination that a default of the obligations hereunder exists, the City shall give

written notice of the alleged material default to the Company and provide it an opportunity to meet with the City officials to discuss a remedy for the alleged default. The Company shall have fifteen (15) days from the receipt of such written notice to respond to the City regarding any alleged monetary default and thirty (30) days from the receipt of such written notice to remedy such alleged monetary default. The Company shall have fifteen (15) days from the receipt of such written notice to respond to the City regarding any alleged non-monetary default and sixty (60) days from the receipt of such written notice to remedy such alleged non-monetary default. The Company may request additional time to cure any alleged monetary or non-monetary default and the City shall reasonably consider said requests.

7. If the Company plans to move from the Property, the City shall be given sixty (60) days advance written notice.
8. In addition to the remedy set forth in Paragraph B.5 hereof, if the Company fails to cure any default within the time period set forth in Paragraph B.6 hereof or if the Company decides to sell its business, or to discontinue the operation thereof, as set forth in Paragraph B.7 hereof, then the City may recapture the value of the tax not paid due to the Exemptions set forth in Paragraph A.1 of this Agreement. Said recapture shall be made through a special assessment on the Company in the municipal fiscal year that follows the EACC's decision to revoke project certification. The assessment, payment, and collection of the special assessment shall be governed by procedures provided for the taxation of omitted property pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 59, Section 75 notwithstanding the time period set forth in said Chapter 59 for which omitted property assessments may be imposed for each of the fiscal years included in the special assessment.
9. The matters described above as obligations of the Company are only conditions to the eligibility for tax exemptions under this Agreement, and do not create any enforceable obligations or covenants of the Company. The City's sole remedy for failure by the Company to satisfy any of its respective obligations and conditions are set forth in Paragraphs B.5 through B.8 of this Agreement.

C. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

1. Pursuant to Chapter 40, Section 59 of the Massachusetts General Laws, this Agreement shall be binding upon the Company, their successors and assigns. As the Company leases the Property, this Agreement does not create any obligations against the owner of the Property, who is not a party to this Agreement, and does not affect any real estate taxes levied against the real property.
2. All notices permitted or required under the provisions of the Agreement shall be in writing, and, if from the Company signed by an authorized officer, and shall be sent by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, or shall be delivered by private express carrier to the addresses listed below or at such other address as may be specified by a party in writing and served upon the other in accordance with this section. Such notices shall be deemed given when delivered or when delivery is refused.

3. The Company agrees to allow the City, and its agents, to monitor compliance with this Agreement. The Company shall provide to the City, upon reasonable request, access to such information as the City, or its agents, may deem necessary to monitor the Company's compliance.
4. This Agreement shall not be binding, and shall not go into effect until fully executed by the parties thereto, and until such time as this Agreement has been approved by the Massachusetts Economic Assistance Coordinating Council.
5. This Agreement is subject to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 23A, Section 3A-3F inclusive, Chapter 40, Section 59, and Chapter 59, Section 5, cl. 51, 760 CMR 22.00, and any other applicable statutes and regulations.

6. Should any provision of the Agreement be declared or determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining parts, terms, and provisions shall not be affected thereby and said illegal or invalid part, term or provision shall be deemed not to be a part of the Agreement.
7. The time within which the Company shall be required to perform any of the respective acts or obligations under this Agreement shall be extended to the extent that the performance of such acts or obligations shall be delayed by a Force Majeure Event and only for so long as said Force Majeure Event has continued. A Force Majeure Event means any supervening events or occurrences, such as acts of God, earthquakes, fire, acts of terrorism, war, labor disputes, delays or restrictions by government bodies; or other causes that are beyond the reasonable control of the Company.



We have an aggressive time frame to relocate our operations as we are expanding rapidly and need additional space. In mid October we identified a location in the City of Fall River MA for the company to be able to expand. The building is a mixed-use building that provides a large enough footprint for us to as quickly as possible, because we are growing rapidly. We have already submitted space plans to the Landlord to see if we can make some improvements, such as to cut through some doorways allowing for two points of egress and give us an additional 4,000 SF of space that we could outfit with desks for additional working space. If we are able to do this, we will be in approximately 10,000 square feet, enough to accommodate new hires. We expect a final design by the end of December at which time we plan to award contract to selected contractor(s). Construction is expected to take 6 - 8 weeks.





## RI tech company eyes future – and more jobs – in Fall River

FALL RIVER — A Rhode Island-based tech company is looking to relocate to Fall River and double its workforce over the next few years.

Representatives of SecZetta Inc., a Newport-based business that describes itself as “the leading provider of non-employee identity risk and lifecycle management software solutions,” met with members of the city’s Tax Increment Finance Board Tuesday to go over a planned tax break the company would receive for relocating to Fall River.

The agreement, which would be based on personal property taxes, was approved by board members Tuesday. Because the agreement would be based on annual personal property assessments the city would have to perform, an exact value of SecZetta’s tax break has yet to be determined. However, estimates included in the agreement show the company could save as much as \$36,800 in Fall River over the next five years.

“We spent a lot of time considering locations. Do we stay in Rhode Island or look at Massachusetts? Fall River is appealing and exciting to us for a multitude of reasons,” said Jason Hobart, SecZetta’s vice president of sales and marketing.

Hobart touted Fall River’s proximity to Boston and the potential of attracting “reverse commuters” as one incentive for looking to move to the city. He also mentioned Fall River’s available real estate and the location’s proximity to a planned commuter rail station as other reasons for moving to an office at 1082 Davol St., site of Commonwealth Landing.

“We really feel that we could be one of those leading software companies that helps drive and cultivate more of a tech hub and tech center,” Hobart said.

By moving to a larger space in Massachusetts, SecZetta predicts that it will more than double the size of its workforce while in Fall River. The company employs 31 people and intends to have a projected headcount of 70 employees by the end of 2021.

Due to the city-issued tax break being built around personal property taxes, and not real estate taxes as Fall River TIFs typically are, TIF Board members requested measures be taken to ensure SecZetta's savings match the company's investments.

"I would like some safeguards in there," said board member Richard Gonsalves. "Every year, we get to go out there, they submit a formal list (of personal property) and we review it. Then, we determine the value of the items."

Personal property under SecZetta's agreement would largely consist of the technological infrastructure the company would need to purchase and maintain after moving to Fall River.

The only dissenting vote Tuesday came from Acting Mayor Cliff Ponte, who expressed interest in seeking further information on the tax break. Following SecZetta's presentation, Ponte said he had hoped the company would have provided a list of the personal property it plans to purchase.

"While I commend you and want to see you grow here in Fall River, I want to present this to the City Council in a way that is thorough," he said. "I'm not in favor of supporting this at this point."

With the approval of the city's TIF Board now secured, SecZetta's tax break will now go before the City Council for approval.

According to the text of SecZetta's TIF agreement, the company plans to employ 93 full-time employees in Fall River by 2025. The company plans to invest approximately \$155,000 in construction costs and approximately \$340,000 in personal property over the next five years.



Dear Fall River City Council,

I am a concerned resident living in the City of Fall River, MA who would like to put a citywide ordinance/legislation on the feeding of stray cats as well as wildlife due to it being a health hazard. Fall River already has an ordinance 34-289 Feeding wild birds and 34-290 Open feeding of domesticated animals and fowl (which does not specify clearly a timeframe or a specific place, I personally think this code 34-290 should not be allowed.) I reside next door to a neighbor who feeds stray cats at night. The cats are multiplying more and more and it's bringing in other creatures such as skunks, possums and raccoons.

I own a dog and we live in a fenced in yard. My dog has cornered a cat in his own fenced in yard and was scratched by a cat on his face near his eyes and nose. (Luckily he did not get bacteria or an infection from this stray cat.) There is cat feces in my yard multiple times a day. Cat feces contain a parasite called Toxoplasmosis. My dog is in harm of becoming ill due to the possibility of ingesting Toxoplasmosis. When my dog gets in contact with this parasite my family and I also have a high possibility of accidentally ingesting this parasite by touching him, because he may have come in contact with infected cat feces.

The cats are a nuisance, it's a citywide problem, as well as a health hazard and something needs to be done about it! I have already spoken with FR Animal Control as well as the FR Board of Health. I got the same answer "there's nothing we can do." The more people provide food for stray cats the more abundant they become. The city already has a problem with rodents and other vermin, so why add to the problem? In order to help control the population of cats we need to put in a legislation on the feeding of cats. When we control the feeding of cats, we can control the spread of parasites to dogs and humans and we can help stop the infestation of rodents and vermin.
