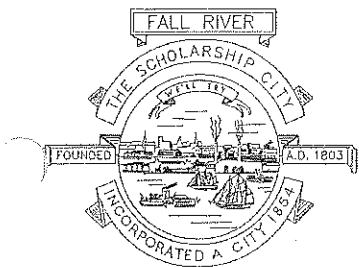

The City Clerk, Alison M. Bouchard called the meeting to order. There was a presentation of the colors by the Fall River Police Department and Fall River Fire Department Honor Guards.

A motion was made by Councilor Shawn E. Cadime and seconded by Councilor Linda M. Pereira to adopt the order. Councilor Pam Laliberte-Lebeau received 6 votes and Councilor Linda M. Pereira received 3 votes, from Councilors Bradford L. Kilby, Trott Lee and Linda M. Pereira. A further motion was made by Councilor Linda M. Pereira and seconded by Councilor Bradford L. Kilby for unanimity and Councilor Pam Laliberte-Lebeau was declared Vice-President of the City Council for the year 2020. Councilor Pam Laliberte-Lebeau was then sworn to her duties by the City Clerk.

Council Vice-President Pam Laliberte-Lebeau delivered remarks.

On a motion made and seconded, it was unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting at 11:25 a.m.

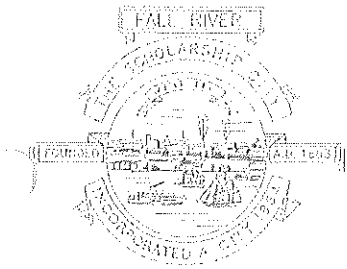
