Job Description:

Under the general supervision of the Director of City Operations as delegated by the Mayor to the City Administrator to perform and/or supervise work involving a variety of skilled and semi-skilled operations in the electricity field. The repair and maintenance of wiring systems in all City owned buildings, including all City owned street lights, generators and electrical components of heating and cooling equipment. Must have a strong understanding of the electrical code, sound industry standards and the ability to read blueprints, schematic drawings, and to perform related duties as required by the Director.

Essential Functions:

- Work involves providing efficient service to the people of the City. The position has the responsibility of performing skilled electrical work and to perform other related and unrelated tasks as assigned by the Director of Facilities Maintenance;
- To be responsible for conformance to federal, state, city codes and standards of all work performed;
- This work is performed with some latitude of action and is performed in conformance with policies and directives as delegated by the Director of Facilities Maintenance; and is subject to periodic review by the Director or his/her designee.
- May perform related work as assigned by Director;
- Installs and repairs electrical systems and make necessary connections;
- Maintains electrical; repairs and replaces defective equipment such as switches, receptacles, light fixtures as needed;
- Ability to read blueprints and construction documents;
- Ability to work on street lights from a bucket truck at various heights;

- Assist other craftspeople like carpenters, painters, plumbers and HVAC mechanics in a variety of projects;
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with peers and supervisors;
- Willingness to work overtime hours as required;
- Ability to perform basic reading and writing functions as required by tasks described above;
- Ability to perform described duties with some latitude for independent judgment under indirect supervision.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Five years of recent, satisfactory, practical paid experience as an electrician or two years of acceptable experience plus sufficient education training in an approved vocational or trade school, in order to complete the five year minimum requirement. Other combinations of experience and training will be considered. Normally, six months practical experience will be credited for each year of educational training. A journeyman electrician's license from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is required.

PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:

This position requires extraordinary physical effort. May experience long periods of bending and reaching; excellent sense of balance; frequent periods of sustained uncomfortable physical positions continuous walking and standing. May be subject to conditions of flooding and/or water plumbing breaks.
