Itinerary for the Annual Great Feast of the Holy Ghost in Fall River

(FALL RIVER, MA-August 15, 2024)- The Great Feast of the Holy Ghost is returning to Fall River this month. The annual celebration will commence on Wednesday, August 21st and conclude on Sunday, August 25th. The Great Feast of the Holy Ghost is one of the largest Azorean celebrations in the world, celebrated annually since 1986.

Residents should be advised that from Wednesday, August 21st to Sunday, August 25th, there will be road closures and potential delays in streets surrounding the Feast. Special parking permits will be administered by the Fall River Police Department to those who live near Kennedy Park. Eligible residents for a parking permit are as follows:

Parking permits will be distributed by the Fall River Police Department on **Wednesday August** 21st from 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. at the FRPD Mobile Command Post located in upper Kennedy Park. Residents must present their current motor vehicle registration to be issued a permit. Permits will only be given to those with MV registrations that reflect vehicles registered to the above addresses.
