PRESS RELEASE

On September 28th 2020, at approximately 2147hrs Officers were dispatched to 21 High St. reference domestic violence complaint.

Upon arrival the victim was found outside the residence. Speaking with the victim she stated her boyfriend, Cheyne Carpenter, 22 years of age, had assaulted her and smashed her phone to prevent her from calling for help.

Further conversation with the victim, she stated Mr. Carpenter possessed a 9mm handgun inside the residence. Franklin Officers tried to make contact with Mr. Carpenter by knocking on the door and using the PA system of their marked cruisers. However Mr. Carpenter did not respond.

When it was determined Mr. Carpenter would not come to the door, it was decided to call out the Warren County Tactical Response Team (WCTRU).

The WCTRU arrived on scene and forced entry, then used their robot to make contact with Mr. Carpenter.

Mr. Carpenter was taken into custody without incident. Mr. Carpenter will be charged with Domestic Violence (M1), Disrupting Public Service (F3), Obstructing Official Business (F5), and Inducing Panic (M1). Mr. Carpenter will be transported to the Warren County Jail for housing, held on \$65,000.00 bond, pending his court date of September 29th 2020 at 1500hrs.
