## Division of Police

### PRESS RELEASE

On March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 Officers were dispatched to Knights Inn, 8500 Claude Thomas Rd. Room 116, Franklin, Ohio on a report of a disturbance.

Upon arrival Officers learned that a male, later identified as Jordan Holt, 20 years of age, had attempted to force entry into Room 116, and the female victim was able to keep the male from completely entering the room. While investigating the complaint Officers received information that Mr. Holt, possibly had a firearm.

Officers made contact with Mr. Holt in room 226 of the Knights Inn, as well as Madison Miller, 18, years of age. While in the room Officers observed a 9mm shell casing, along with drug paraphernalia. Mr. Holt, and Ms. Miller were taken into custody.

Continuing the investigation, it was determined that a second male, at a different location also had a firearm. Officers located this male, Adam Foster, 34 years of age, on Franklin Trenton Rd. and stopped his vehicle. A firearm was located in the vehicle, and Mr. Foster was taken into custody. A female was also located in the vehicle and it was found that Mr. Holt allegedly shot at her several times in room 226 of the Knights Inn.

When Officer Lexis Wallace was walking Madison Miller into the Police Department, she observed a change in Ms. Miller's pants. A second pat down of Ms. Miller revealed she had hidden a firearm in the crotch area of her pants.

After interviews were conducted, **Jordan Holt** was charged with F-2 Felonious Assault, F-2 Burglary, Two F-5 Drug Possession charges, and One M-1 Drug Charge. **Madison Miller** was charged with F-3 Illegal Conveyance of a Weapon, and F-4 Carrying Concealed Weapons. **Adam Foster** was charged with F-3 Weapons Under Disability.

Jordon Holt's bond is \$245,00.00, Madison Miller's bond is \$60,000.00 and Adam Foster's bond is \$40,000.00. All three are housed at the Warren County Jail, pending their court date of March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 1300hrs.
