Press Release

On August 15th, 2021, at approx. 0927hrs Officer responded to a Domestic Situation from 12 Maple St.

The victim was interviewed, and it was determined that charges of Domestic Violence and Felonious Assault would be signed on Steven Langdon, 49-year-old male. Officers responded to 12 Maple St. to make contact with Mr. Langdon and take him into custody. Mr. Langdon would not come to the door, and Officers could see him looking out of a window. The victim advised Mr. Langdon had a handgun and large knife, so Officers decided to hold a perimeter and call out the Warren County Tactical Response Unit (SWAT).

Warren County Tactical Response Unit arrived, and negotiators made contact with Mr. Langdon. When Negotiations were not effective the Warren County Tactical Response Unit deployed gas into the residence on several different occasions.

Mr. Langdon eventually came out of the residence and was taken into custody without further incident.

Mr. Langdon was treated and released on scene by Franklin Fire/EMS due to his exposure to the gas deployed in the residence.

Mr. Langdon was transported to the Warren County Jail, held on No Bond, pending his court date of August 17th, 2021, at 1500hrs.
