RESOLUTION 2017-21

**AWARDING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT WITH  
ADLETA CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE 2017 CURB REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, bids for the 2017 Curb Replacement Project were opened on March 29, 2017, in accordance with the Notice to Bidders;

WHEREAS, the lowest bid, from Jackson Construction, Inc. was nonresponsive as it failed to provide items required in the Instruction to Bidders and the Bid Documents;

WHEREAS, it is determined by Council that the bid from Adleta Construction, Inc., is the lowest and best; and

WHEREAS, this Council, by Ordinance 2017-02 has authorized the expenditure of funds for said contract through the appropriation of funds in the City's operating budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of the members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The Bid for the 2017 Curb Replacement Project is hereby awarded to Adleta Construction, Inc., 389 S. Wayne Ave., Cincinnati, OH 45215, in the total bid amount of \$178,900, all in accordance with the Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby directed to execute a contract with Adleta Construction, Inc., for the 2017 Curb Replacement Project, in accordance with Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet upon which the bid was received. The costs of the contract shall be paid out of the funds appropriated for it in the City's operating budget.

Section 3. The Bid from Jackson Construction, Inc., 5245 Thomas Road, Trenton, Ohio, 45067, is hereby rejected for being nonresponsive.

Section 4. It is hereby found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
