RESOLUTION 2017-37

**AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE FOR THE POLICE DIVISION  
FROM LEBANON FORD THROUGH THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM  
AND THE EQUIPPING OF THE SAME**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its residents to purchase new police vehicles on a yearly rotation;

WHEREAS, Council wishes to utilize the State of Ohio's Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program to make said purchases, which does not require competitive bidding pursuant to state law;

WHEREAS, the selected vendor under the DAS State Purchasing Program is Lebanon Ford, under Bid Contract #RS900917-3, Index #GDC050;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City's Charter, competitive bidding is not required when not required pursuant to state law, but Council must approve the expenditure of funds when the contract price exceeds Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase, on behalf of the City's Police Division, one 2017 Ford Utility Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicle, in the total amount of Twenty-Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and No Cents (\$26,129.00), pursuant to the State Purchasing Program, from Lebanon Ford, 770 Columbus Avenue, Lebanon, Ohio 45036.

Section 2. The Police Division is hereby authorized to contract with Phoenix E.N.G., Inc., 6832 Foxhill Lane, Cincinnati, Ohio, 45219, to equip said police vehicle including, but not limited to, in-car cameras and new radios, in an amount not to exceed Ten Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty-One Dollars and No Cents (\$10,381.00).

Section 4. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
