RESOLUTION 2017-38

**AWARDING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT
WITH W.G. STANG, LLC, FOR THE 2017 SIDEWALK REPAIR PROJECT**

WHEREAS, bids for the 2017 Sidewalk Repair Project were opened on June 21, 2017, in accordance with the Notice to Bidders;

WHEREAS, the City received four bids, all of which exceeded the Engineer's estimate for the Project, but Ohio Revised Code Section 153.12 allows a contract to be awarded when the bid amount does not exceed ten percent of the Engineer's estimate for the Project;

WHEREAS, it is determined by Council that the bid from W.G. Stang, LLC, is the lowest and best; and

WHEREAS, this Council, by Resolution 2017-10 and Ordinance 2017-12, has authorized this Project and the expenditure of funds for said contract through the appropriation of funds in the City's operating budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of the members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The Bid for the 2017 Sidewalk Repair Project is hereby awarded to W.G. Stang, LLC, 2403 Jacksonburg Rd., Hamilton, Ohio, 45011, in the total bid amount of One Hundred Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$112,950), all in accordance with the Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby directed to execute a contract with W.G. Stang, LLC, for the 2017 Sidewalk Repair Project in accordance with Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans and other documents contained in the bid packet upon which the bid was received. The costs of the contract shall be paid out of the funds appropriated for it in the City's operating budget.

Section 3. It is hereby found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
