**APPOINTING JULIE WIEBUSCH TO THE BOARD OF ZONING, BUILDING  
AND HOUSING APPEALS**

WHEREAS, a vacancy currently exists on the City of Franklin Board of Zoning, Building and Housing Appeals, due to the resignation of Brian Sleeth; and

WHEREAS, Julie Wiebusch, a resident of Franklin has indicated her desire to fill said vacancy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that:

Section 1. Ms. Julie Wiebusch, 209 Oxford Road, Franklin, Ohio, is hereby appointed to the Board of Zoning, Building and Housing Appeals to fill the remainder of a four-year term, ending December 31, 2019, and in accordance with the City Charter, shall continue in office until her successor is appointed.

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
