RESOLUTION 2018-15

**AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN CITY-OWNED VEHICLES
BY THE AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Public Work Department have vehicles that are no longer needed, but the estimated value of which is over \$1,000; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 115.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Franklin, this Council must determine that said property is no longer needed for any municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 115.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Franklin, upon the determination that said property is no longer needed for any municipal purpose this Council may, by resolution, authorize the sale of said property by bid or auction, including internet auction, or by sale to another governmental entity without competitive bidding,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members that:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the following City-owned vehicles, 1991 GMC Truck, VIN #1GDM7H1JOMJ508919 and a 1995 GMC Truck, VIN #1GDP7H1J5SJ509638, all under the management of the Public Works Department, are not needed for any municipal purpose. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sell said vehicles by bid or auction, or may sell such property to another governmental entity without competitive bidding.

Section 3. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
