RESOLUTION 2018-22

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A FOUR TON BLACKTOP HOPPER FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FROM SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its residents to purchase a mini excavator for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to utilize the State of Ohio's Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program to make said purchase, which does not require competitive bidding pursuant to State law; and

WHEREAS, the selected vendor under the DAS State Purchasing Program is Southeastern Equipment, under Index #STS515, Bid Contract #800344; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City's Charter, competitive bidding is not required when not required pursuant to state law, but Council must approve the expenditure of funds when the contract price exceeds Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase, on behalf of the City's Public Works Department, a 4 ton blacktop hopper in the amount of Forty Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$40,975.50), pursuant to the Ohio DAS Cooperative Purchasing Program, from Southeastern Equipment Company, Inc., 404 Breaden Road, Monroe, Ohio 45050. The funds for this purchase shall come from the Water Fund, in accordance with the Public Works Department's 2018 Budget.

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
