RESOLUTION 2018-23

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A FREIGHTLINER DUMP TRUCK FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE ODOT COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its residents to purchase a new dump truck for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, this Council, by Resolution 2018-08, passed on February 5, 2018, requested that the City be authorized to participate in contracts awarded by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT); and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to utilize the ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program to make said purchase, which does not require competitive bidding pursuant to state law; and

WHEREAS, ODOT has given authority for the City to participate in Contract 023-18, which will allow the City to purchase a new dump truck from Stoops Freightliner; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City's Charter, competitive bidding is not required when not required pursuant to state law, but Council must approve the expenditure of funds when the contract price exceeds Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of Councilmembers present concurring, that;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase, on behalf of the City's Public Works Department, a Freightliner Dump Truck, with accessories, in the total amount of Seventy-Three Thousand Six Hundred and Seventy-Three Dollars (\$73,673), pursuant to Contract 023-18 under the ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program, from Stoops Freightliner, 7800 Center Point 70 Blvd., Dayton, Ohio, 45424.

Section 2. The City Manager is further authorized to enter into a contract with the KE Rose Company, 4595 Chambersburg Rd., Huber Heights, Ohio, 45424, to equip and outfit said Dump Truck, in an amount not to exceed Forty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$43,500).

Section 3. The cost of this purchase and the equipping and outfitting shall be paid from the funds appropriated for the same by this Council in the City's operating budget.

Section 4. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
