RESOLUTION 2018-24

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE
OF A NEW TAHOE FOUR WHEEL DRIVE VEHICLE FOR THE FIRE & EMS DIVISION
FROM TIM LALLY CHEVROLET THROUGH THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Franklin Division of Fire & EMS is in need of a new vehicle for use by the Division in hauling equipment and responding to emergency scenes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04, the City has passed the necessary resolution to participate in the State of Ohio's Department of Administrative Services' State Purchasing Program, which exempts purchases made under the program from competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to utilize the State of Ohio's Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program to purchase the necessary new sport utility vehicle for the Fire & EMS Division; and

WHEREAS, the selected vendor under the DAS State Purchasing Program is Tim Lally Chevrolet, under Schedule #RS900718, Index #GDC050; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City's Charter, competitive bidding is not required when not required pursuant to state law, but Council must approve the expenditure of funds when the contract price exceeds Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000); and

WHEREAS, this Council has authorized the expenditure of funds for said purchases through the appropriation of funds in the City's operating budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, that;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a contract with Tim Lally Chevrolet, 24999 Miles Road, Warrensville Hts, Ohio, 44128, for the purchase of a 2018 Tahoe, 4WD, 5W4 vehicle, with selected options, in the total amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-One Dollars and 60 Cents (\$35,521.60), pursuant to the DAS State Purchasing Program, Schedule #RS900718, Index #GD050, Item Number 31AT.

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
