RESOLUTION 2018-25

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A RESCUE/ ENGINE FROM ROSENBAUER SOUTH DAKOTA, LLC. THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES STATE TERM SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its residents to purchase a Rosenbauer Pumper Apparatus Body manufactured by Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC and specified equipment, and commander chassis Rescue Engine for the Fire & EMS Division to provide emergency medical services to City residents; and

WHEREAS, Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC. currently has a State contract to sell rescue vehicles with the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Schedule #STS618, Contract #800369; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to State law, competitive bidding is not required when an item can be directly purchased for less than the State-bid amount; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City's Charter, competitive bidding is not required when not required pursuant to State law, but Council must approve the expenditure of funds when the contract price exceeds Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a Lease-to-Own contract with the Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC., for the purchase of a Rosenbauer Pumper Apparatus Body & Specified Equipment and Rosenbauer Commander Chassis in the total amount of Six Hundred Six Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$606,979.00), to be made in five-yearly payments of One Hundred Thirty-One Thousand, Two Hundred Nine Dollars and Twenty-Four Cents (131,209.24), upon such terms and conditions as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
