RESOLUTION 2018-33

**AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FOUR POLICE VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE
DIVISION FROM GREVE CHRYSLER JEEP DODGE THROUGH THE STATE PURCHASING
PROGRAM AND THE EQUIPPING OF THE SAME**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its residents to purchase new police vehicles on a yearly rotation;

WHEREAS, Council wishes to utilize the State of Ohio's Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program to make said purchases, which does not require competitive bidding pursuant to state law;

WHEREAS, the selected vendor under the DAS State Purchasing Program is Greve Chrysler Jeep Dodge, under Bid Contract #RS900718-1, Index #GDC050;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City's Charter, competitive bidding is not required when not required pursuant to state law, but Council must approve the expenditure of funds when the contract price exceeds Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase, on behalf of the City's Police Division, four 2018 Dodge Chargers, in the total amount of Ninety Four Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Four Dollars and No Cents (\$94,444.00), pursuant to the State Purchasing Program, from Greve Chrysler Jeep Dodge, 756 West Ervin Road, Van Wert, Ohio 45891.

Section 2. The Police Division is hereby authorized to contract with Phoenix E.N.G., Inc., 6832 Foxhill Lane, Cincinnati, Ohio, 45219, in the amount of \$34,712.00 and with L3 Mobile Vision, Inc., 400 Commons Way, Rockaway, NJ 07866, in the amount of \$20,324.00 to equip said police vehicles.

Section 4. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
