RESOLUTION 2018-45

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A FINAL APPLICATION FOR THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION'S STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS, AS REQUIRED, FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2019 (PY 33) FOR THE DOWNTOWN SIGNAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM PHASE 1 PROJECT AND THE HAROLD STREET ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin is planning to make capital improvements by completing the Downtown Signal Management System Phase 1 Project, which will make improvements to the signals/intersections along Second Street at River Street, Main Street and Riley Blvd., and the Harold Street Roadway Improvements Project, which will make roadway improvements to Harold Street, from East Second Street to Virginia Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements projects herein above-described are considered to be priority needs for the community and are qualified projects under the OPWC programs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds for capital improvements and/or local transportation improvements for the Downtown Signal Management System Phase 1 Project and the Harold Street Roadway Improvements Project for the Program Year 2019 (PY 33).

Section 2. The City Manager is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate to obtain financial assistance for these two Projects.

Section 3. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
