RESOLUTION 2018-58

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A REGIONAL AND A LOCAL APPLICATION FOR THE 2019 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE FIRE & EMS DIVISION

WHEREAS, the 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program provides federal funds to assist in the purchase of equipment needed by Fire & EMS providers;

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Division of Fire & EMS is in need of certain Fire, EMS and personnel equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin will submit a regional application along with Franklin Township and the Village of Carlisle to receive grant monies to replace the entire SCBA fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin will also submit a local application to receive grant monies to replace the City's SCBA cylinders and extrication equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of Councilmembers present concurring, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby directed to file a regional application, and to submit any needed information or documentation required with said application, for a grant under the 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program. The grant application shall be for the purchase of Self Contained Breath Apparatus (SCBA equipment) for the City of Franklin, Franklin Township and Village of Carlisle. The three entities have a mutual agreement to share the local share cost of the grant, and shall be for the following amounts:

Total Purchase Cost:	\$ 597,793.00
Local Share (10%)	\$ 59,779.30 (City of Franklin \$25,461.70; Carlisle \$10,341.70 & Franklin Township \$23,975.90)

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby directed to file a local application, and to submit any needed information or documentation required with said application, for a grant under the 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program. The grant application shall be for the purchase of Self Contained Breath Apparatus (SCBA Equipment) and Extrication Equipment, and shall be for the following amounts:

Total Purchase Cost:	\$106,932.00
Local Share (5%)	\$ 5,346.00

Section 3. This Council hereby acknowledges and agrees that if the City's application (regional or local) is approved, participation in the 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program will require compliance with the Program's guidelines and assurances.

Section 4. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
