RESOLUTION 2019-15

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO POLICE VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE DIVISION FROM GREVE CHRYSLER JEEP DODGE AND GANLEY CHEVROLET OF AURORA THROUGH THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FROM VARIOUS SUPPLIERS TO OUTFIT NEW VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its law enforcement officers and the community it serves to purchase new police vehicles on a yearly rotation;

WHEREAS, Council wishes to utilize the State of Ohio's Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program to make said purchases, which does not require competitive bidding pursuant to state law;

WHEREAS, the selected vendor under the DAS State Purchasing Program is Greve Chrysler Jeep Dodge, under Bid Contract #RS901519-1, Index #GDC050 and Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora, under Bid Contract #RS901519-3, Index #GDC050; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City's Charter, competitive bidding is not required when not required pursuant to state law, but Council must approve the expenditure of funds when the contract price exceeds Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase, on behalf of the City's Police Division, the following two vehicles: A) one (1) 2019 Dodge Charger, in the total amount of Twenty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Seven Dollars and No Cents (\$24,907.00), pursuant to the State Purchasing Program, from Greve Chrysler Jeep Dodge, 756 West Ervin Road, Van Wert, Ohio 45891 and B) one (1) 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD, in the total amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-One Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$35,391.80) from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora, 310 West Garfield, Aurora, Oh 44202.

Section 2. The Police Division is hereby authorized to contract with the following in order to outfit the two new vehicles with equipment necessary for police functions:

Phoenix Upfitters, 2400 Carmody Blvd, Middletown, Ohio 45042, in the amount of Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred and Seventy Nine Dollars and No Cents (\$13,379.00) for emergency equipment and installation of vehicle stripping, radio and camera systems for the Tahoe;

Phoenix Upfitters, 2400 Carmody Blvd, Middletown, Ohio 45042, in the amount of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety Dollars and No Cents (\$7,990.00) for emergency equipment and installation of vehicle stripping, radio and camera systems for the Dodge Charger;

L3 Mobile Vision, Inc., 400 Commons Way, Rockaway, NJ 07866, in the amount of Ten Thousand Three Hundred and Forty Two Dollars and No Cents (\$10,342.00) for camera equipment for the Dodge Charger & Tahoe;

Mobile Comm, 1211 W. Sharon Road, Cincinnati, Oh 45240 in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Four Dollars and No Cents (\$1,284.00) for radio equipment for the Dodge Charger & Tahoe.

Section 4. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
