RESOLUTION 2019-17

**AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A SCHWARZE A7 TORNADO STREET SWEEPER
FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FROM SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT
COMPANY THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES
COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its residents to purchase a street sweeper for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, Southeastern Equipment Company currently has a State contract to sell street sweepers with the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Schedule #STS235, Contract #800706; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to State law, competitive bidding is not required when an item can be directly purchased for less than the State-bid amount; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City's Charter, competitive bidding is not required when not required pursuant to State law, but Council must approve the expenditure of funds when the contract price exceeds Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a Lease-to-Own contract with Southeastern Equipment Company, Inc., for the purchase of a Schwarze A7 Tornado Regenerative Air Street Sweeper in the total amount of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars and Forty-Eight Cents (\$240,324.48), to be made in five yearly payments of Fifty One Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty Five Dollars and Forty Eight Cents (\$51,885.48), upon such terms and conditions as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
