RESOLUTION 2019-22

**AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT OF UP TO \$3,000 TO WARREN COUNTY KUSTOMS
FOR THE 2019 FRANKLIN DOWNTOWN SATURDAY NIGHT CAR SHOW**

WHEREAS, Warren County Kustoms has sponsored and organized the "Downtown Saturday Night" car show, which has brought nationwide recognition to the City of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, Warren County Kustoms is planning the "Downtown Saturday Night" car show for August 10, 2019, which the event will benefit all businesses in the Franklin area; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin wishes to support an event that is beneficial to our community; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires that City Council take action of a special or temporary nature by resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The Finance Director is hereby directed to make reimbursement of up to three thousand dollars (\$3,000) to Warren County Kustoms, as approved by the City Manager. Said funds shall be used for expenses directly related to the City of Franklin 2019 "Downtown Saturday Night" car show, and the Finance Director shall require the submission of invoices or statements for any such expenses before such expenses are reimbursed.

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.

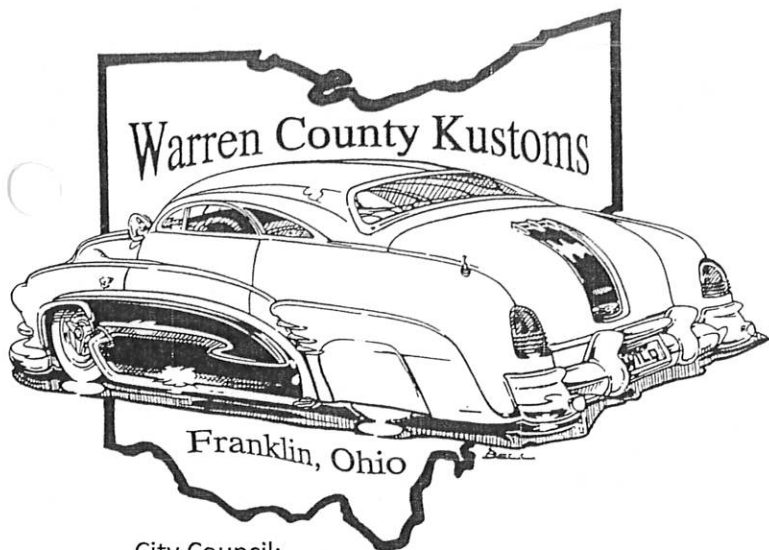
