RESOLUTION 2019-35

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION'S STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS, AS REQUIRED, FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2021 (PY 35) FOR THE DOWNTOWN SIGNALS PHASE TWO PROJECT AND THE WILLIAM GOOD BLVD. – SCHOLL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure;

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin is planning to make capital improvements by completing the Downtown Signals Phase Two Project, which will make improvements to the traffic signals at the S. Riley Boulevard at Fourth Street intersection, S. Riley Boulevard at E. Sixth Street intersection and the E. Sixth Street at Anderson Street intersection; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin is planning to make capital improvements by completing the extension of William Good Boulevard to Scholl Road and also by milling and resurfacing Scholl Road; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement projects herein above described are considered to be a priority need for the community and are qualified projects under the OPWC programs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds for capital improvements and/or local transportation improvements for the Program Year 2021 (PY 35) for


1. the Downtown Signals Phase Two Project
2. the William Good Blvd. - Scholl Road Improvement Project.

Section 2. The City Manager is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate to obtain financial assistance for this Project.

Section 3. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.


