RESOLUTION 2019-40

**AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF DE-ICING SALT FROM CARGILL INC. THROUGH
THE WARREN COUNTY ENGINEER'S JOINT SALT PURCHASING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Resolution 2019-12, passed by this Council on March 4, 2019, authorized participation in the Warren County Engineer's Joint Salt Purchasing Program for the purpose of purchasing road salt for the 2019-2020 winter season;

WHEREAS, the Warren County Engineer accepted reverse online bids for de-icing salt, delivered and dumped, until May 23, 2019, and determined that the bid of the Cargill, Inc. was the lowest and best; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Warren County, by Resolution 19-0727, passed on June 11, 2019, awarded the bid for the Warren County Engineer's Joint Salt Purchasing Program to the Cargill, Inc.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of the members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase up to three thousand (3,000) tons of deicing salt from Cargill, Inc. through the Warren County Engineer's Joint Salt Purchasing Program, at a price of \$84.40 per ton, dumped.

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Rules of Council.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
