RESOLUTION 2019-49

**PRELIMINARY LEGISLATION GRANTING CONSENT TO ODOT FOR BRIDGE INSPECTION
PROGRAM SERVICES**

The following Resolution is enacted by the City of Franklin, Warren County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency “(LPA)”, in the matter of the project described herein.

SECTION I — Project Description

WHEREAS, the LPA has identified the need for the following described project (“Project”):

Bridge Inspection Program Services, including, but not limited to routine inspections, element level inspections, critical-findings reports, fracture critical member inspections, load rating calculations and reports, weight limits posting sign recommendations, scour assessments, scour plan of action, development of fracture critical plans, and underwater dive inspection reports if needed.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of Council members present concurring, that:

SECTION II — Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the Project.

SECTION III — Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the Project as follows:

The State (ODOT) shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs for Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the LPA and agreed to by ODOT. Eligible Bridge Inspection Services are described in the Consultant’s Scope of Services Task Order Contract (Exhibit A).

The LPA shall assume 100% of the cost of those features which are not included in Exhibit A. Those features may include but not limited to the purchasing and erecting the recommended weight limits postings signs, the implementation of critical findings reports such as partial or total bridge closures, the implementation of the scour plan of actions. When recommendations affect public safety, ODOT expects full implementation by the LPA. Starting in October 2019, FHWA requires installing weight limits posting signs within 30 days from the official date of the approved recommendations. Timely implementation is essential to the success of this program.

SECTION IV — Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the Project will be made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations.

SECTION V — Authority to Sign

The City Manager of said City of Franklin is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of Franklin to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the Project.

SECTION VI - Sunshine Law

It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

SECTION VII - Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.


