**AWARDING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT WITH
RACK AND BALLAUER EXCAVATING CO., INC. FOR THE I-75 SOUTHBOUND RAMP
AT SR 73 CULVERT EXTENSION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, bids for the I-75 Southbound Ramp at SR 73 Culvert Extension Project were opened on December 11, 2019, in accordance with the Notice to Bidders;

WHEREAS, it is determined by Council that the bid from Rack and Ballauer Excavating Co., Inc. is the lowest and best; and

WHEREAS, this Council, by Ordinance 2019-01 has authorized the expenditure of funds for said contract through the appropriation of funds in the City's operating budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of the members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The Bid for the I-75 Southbound Ramp at SR 73 Culvert Extension Project is hereby awarded to Rack and Ballauer Excavating Co., Inc., 11321 Paddy's Run Road, Hamilton, Ohio 45013, in the total bid amount of One Hundred and Seven Thousand, Six Hundred and Ninety Seven Dollars and Zero Cents (\$107,697.00), all in accordance with the Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby directed to execute a contract with Rack and Ballauer Excavating Co., Inc. for the I-75 Southbound Ramp at SR 73 Culvert Extension Project, in accordance with Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet upon which the bid was received. The costs of the contract shall be paid out of the funds appropriated for it in the City's operating budget.

Section 3. It is hereby found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
