RESOLUTION 2020-39

AWARDING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT WITH VOGELPOHL FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF AGING SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS (SCBA) FOR THE JOINT GRANT PROJECT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP AND THE VILLAGE OF CARLISLE

WHEREAS, bids for replacement of aging Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) for the joint grant project between the City of Franklin, Franklin Township and the Village of Carlisle were opened on June 24, 2020, in accordance with the Notice to Bidders;

WHEREAS, it is determined by Council that the bid from Vogelpohl Fire Equipment is the lowest and best; and

WHEREAS, this Council, by Ordinance 2020-09 has authorized the expenditure of funds for said contract through the appropriation of funds in the City’s operating budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The bid packet was sent to several preferred bidders and only one bid was submitted to the City of Franklin.

Section 2. The bid for the replacement of aging SCBA for the joint grant project between the City of Franklin, Franklin Township and the Village of Carlisle is hereby awarded to Vogelpohl Fire Equipment, the sole bidder, in the total bid amount of \$557,905.50 all in accordance with the Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet.

Section 3. As this is a joint grant project, below is the breakdown of the grant and non-grant financial responsibility for each entity making purchases through this joint grant project:

Section 4. The City Manager is hereby directed to execute a contract and all other necessary documents with Vogelpohl Fire Equipment for the replacement of the SCBA, in accordance with Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet upon which the bid was received. The costs of the contract shall be paid out of the funds appropriated for it in the City’s operating budget and the Finance Director is authorized to sign all necessary documents and to take all required steps to carry out the acceptance of this bid.

Section 5. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
