RESOLUTION 2020-64

**AWARDING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT WITH
FORD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE 2020 3RD STREET LIFT STATION
REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, bids for the 2020 3rd Street Lift Station Replacement Project were opened on December 2, 2020, in accordance with the Notice to Bidders;

WHEREAS, it is determined by Council that the bid from Ford Development Corporation is the lowest and best; and

WHEREAS, this Council, by Ordinance 2020-04 authorized the expenditure of funds for said contract through the appropriation of funds in the City's operating budget, and this authorized expenditure has been approved in supplemental appropriations, Ordinance 2020-12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of the members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The Bid for the 2020 3rd Street Lift Station Replacement Project is hereby awarded to Ford Development Corporation, 11148 Woodward Lane, Cincinnati, Ohio 45241, in the total bid amount of Six Hundred Forty Eight Thousand and Zero Cents (\$648,000.00), all in accordance with the Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby directed to execute a contract and all other necessary documents with Ford Development Corporation for the 2020 3rd Street Lift Station Replacement Project, in accordance with Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Specifications, Plans, and other documents contained in the bid packet upon which the bid was received. The costs of the contract shall be paid out of the funds appropriated for it in the City's operating budget.

Section 3. It is hereby found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
