RESOLUTION 2021-08

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR THE 2021
ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT**

WHEREAS, the 2021 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program provides federal funds to assist in the purchase of equipment needed by fire departments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Division of Fire is in need of a SCBA washer to clean and decontaminate the breathing apparatus firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Division of Fire is in need of a turnout gear dryer to improve comfort while eliminating mold and bacteria; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Division of Fire is in need of an AeroClave to decontaminate apparatus and large spaces within the station utilizing hands free cleaning of apparatus, rooms and equipment, with the ability to hand spray smaller items; and

WHEREAS, if the application is approved, the City will receive grant monies equal to ninety-five percent (95%) of the total purchase cost; and

WHEREAS, the City's percent (5%) local matching share of the total purchase cost has been budgeted for.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby directed to execute and file an application and to execute and submit any needed information or documentation required with said application, for a grant under the 2021 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program. The grant application shall be for:

Total Purchase Cost:	\$ 54,066.00
Grant Funding (95%)	\$ 51,362.70
Local Share (5%)	\$ 2,703.30

Section 2. This Council hereby acknowledges and agrees that if the City's application is approved, participation in the 2021 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program will require compliance with the Program's guidelines and assurances.

Section 3. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
