

CITY OF FRANKLIN, OHIO
RESOLUTION 2023-39

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A SAFE STREETS FOR ALL GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, administers financial assistance for Planning and Demonstration Grants through the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin desires financial assistance under the SS4A Grant Program to improve roadway safety and reduce or eliminate roadway fatalities and serious injuries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit, on behalf of the City of Franklin, a Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Planning and Demonstration Grant application with the U.S. Department of Transportation for financial assistance to develop a complete comprehensive safety action plan. This work would provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance.

Section 2. This Council does hereby agree to obligate any funds necessary to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the SS4A Grant Program, if the City's application for financial assistance is approved.

Section 3. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
