RESOLUTION 2023-47

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE OHIO AMBULANCE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio was awarded funds from the U.S. Treasury as Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (Assistance Listing No. 21.027), authorized pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), Pub. L. No. 117-2 (March 11, 2021).; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 280.10 of Amended Substitute House Bill 45 (H.B. 45) of the 134th General Assembly, the Ohio Office of Budget and Management (OBM) was appropriated \$20,000,000 to administer grants to any public, not-for-profit, or private ground ambulance transport provider, who submitted claims to the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) during state fiscal year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the ODM has provided OBM with a list of eligible ambulance transport providers and their associated distributions of funding and the City of Franklin is eligible for up to \$20,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin desires financial assistance for COVID-19 Mitigation and Prevention Costs related to the purchase of an E-450 Ambulance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit, on behalf of the City of Franklin, an Ohio Ambulance Transportation Program grant application for financial assistance for COVID-19 Mitigation and Prevention Costs related to the purchase of an E-450 Ambulance in 2021. This work would provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance.

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
