The consensus from the Public Meeting on Wednesday, September 4, 2024, is that the current residents were not in favor of selling their property. He stated the time and cost that the city would incur to acquire the property would be costly, adding he has a problem forcing someone to sell their homes when there is no benefit to the community.

Alderperson Eavenson added there would be a significant amount of money spent by the city on top of the grant, agreeing with the Mayor that forcing citizens to sell their property is a hard thing to do. Discussion by council with the consensus that the Alderpersons do not agree with forcing citizens to sell their property in this instance.

Motion by Alderperson Harrington, seconded by Alderperson Davis to not pursue any action with the Maryville Round-a-Bout, ending the discussion and further action. All voted yes, motion carried.

Alderperson Eavenson stated the city would continue to look for solutions to traffic problems in that area.

Alderperson Hawkins stated he would like to see the Ordinance protected by a "Super Majority" vote to protect the money used, and any changes made to the Ordinance, adding we need to make sure the funds are there for future obligations.

Mayor Parkinson agreed with Alderperson Hawkins, adding the city had to ensure there are funds on hand to ensure we can meet pension payments and continue doing what we told the citizens we were going to do to make the city financially stable.

Fire Chief Todd Richey advised the council there was one qualifying bid for the RFP for construction/remodel/abatement and HVAC, adding he was impressed with the walk through he did with the company that had bid.

Mayor Parkinson questioned if the bid was within the amount budgeted. Chief Richey stated the budgeted amount for the project was \$300,000 and the bid was for \$289,268.
