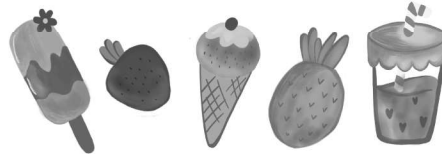

- Topical and oral parasite preventatives
- Timothy hay
- Guinea pig food
- Small animal bedding
- Blankets
- Bath towels
- Most new or gently used* pet supplies, including but not limited to:
 - Toys, beds, collars, harnesses, leashes, crates and carriers, pet apparel and accessories
