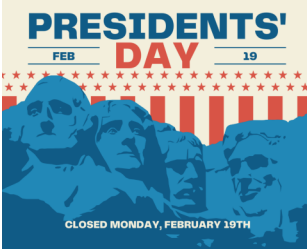

Message from Central Linn School District

A group of up to 20 parents, alumni, community members, staff, and students of the Central Linn School District have formed a Community Bond Advisory Committee (CBAC). These volunteers will spend the next 12 months evaluating the district's facilities and proposing solutions to the Central Linn School Board of Directors on proposed plans to include community and school needs.

The committee will work with Wenaha Group, a Construction Management and Consulting Firm that specializes in K-12 construction in medium-sized and rural school districts. Wenaha will plan and facilitate the CBAC's meetings, while the committee will ultimately decide what recommendations to make to the Board.

Community engagement is crucial in this process, and we are grateful to those who've

volunteered to serve on the CBAC," explained Central Linn Superintendent, Candace Pelt, Ed.D. "The group will be charged with evaluating the needs of our community and our students to determine how to best create inclusive and dynamic learning environments with a strategic eye on fiscal responsibility."

Part of the initial work is to conduct a facilities assessment and develop a long-range facilities plan. The CBAC will prioritize the community's needs and wants for district facilities, draft a recommendation, solicit community feedback, and then present a final recommendation to the Board. If the committee recommends that the Board pursue a general obligation bond, the Board would decide whether to refer it to voters on the May 2025 ballot. The first committee meeting is scheduled for January 23, 2024

Central Linn Rec Center Open House

The recent Rec Center renovation has been a “head-to-toe” update of the facility. Fire and Life Safety are driving many of the decisions. The gymnasium has been redone with a new scoreboard, backboards, an updated stage area, storage rooms, restrooms, upgraded kitchen, and a large meeting room. Accessibility is improved with ADA ramps and entrances for the facility. New HVAC, electrical, and plumbing are included. Other upgrades include small seismic modifications, replacement of all the windows and doors, and paint for the entire building, inside and out.

The Rec Center has been renovated with the intention of using the facility for at least fifty more years. The renovation began early summer 2023, and is nearing completion.

The City of Brownsville will be holding an open house for the public to view the newly refurbished facility on February 22nd, 2024 from 7:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. The renovation project has been a mix of preserving the old, and embracing new modifications and upgrades.
