The fees for the examination, handling, inspection, review, and storage of applications for the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Operation and Maintenance of an Air Quality Monitoring Network are listed below.

Exceptions

- 1. No fee imposed may be charged to the State or any political subdivision thereof, including educational facilities or medical facilities owned by the State or political subdivision.
- 2. No fee imposed may be charged to any person exempted from taxation by Ohio Revised Code 5709.07 or 5709.12.

Legal Background

The Southwest Ohio Air Quality Agency is a Local Air Pollution Control Authority as defined in Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.01(N). The agency acts as a contractual agent for both the Ohio and United States Environmental Protection Agencies. Primarily, Local Air Pollution Control Authorities are responsible for the permitting and inspection of air pollution sources, complaint investigations, enforcement of air pollution regulations, and the operation of Air Quality Monitoring networks. The specific Local Air Pollution Control Authority powers and duties are specified in ORC 3704.112. As provided for in ORC 3709.085(A), Boards of Health or General Health Districts may enter into a contract with a Local Air Pollution Control Authority to obtain or provide all or part of any services, including, but not limited to, enforcement services, for the purposes of Air Pollution Control Regulations specified in ORC 3704, the rules adopted and orders made pursuant thereto, or any other ordinances or rules for the prevention, control, and abatement of air pollution.

These contracts or resolutions between Boards of Health or General Health District and Local Air Pollution Control Authorities serve as the regulatory basis for the Local Enforcement Process and the collection of air pollution control fees as specified in ORC 3709.09.
