The Hamilton County Commission on Women & Girls was created in 2017 to make recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners and local government jurisdictions to eliminate gender inequality in a wide range of areas, including political, economic, social, cultural, or civic fields. The Commission consists of twenty adult members and ten student members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. Members **must** be residents of Hamilton County, Ohio and are appointed for two-year terms (adult members) or one-year terms (student members).

All members (both adults and students) are expected to attend all required in-person meetings, held monthly on Saturday mornings and are typically 9:30am – 12:00pm, with a few exceptions. Sub-committees may meet separately as needed. Additional independent work (including research, individual meetings, etc.) is also expected.
