HAYDEN DAYS PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The CITY OF HAYDEN or its designated representative has the right to refuse entry into the parade and/or remove from the parade, any individual or group that does not conform to the rules and regulations as outlined below:

- 1. There will be no materials, candy or handouts of any kind distributed by the parade unit if the unit is in a moving vehicle or device. Said items may only be distributed by walking participants. This rule applies to the entire parade route.
- 2. Persons or units not listed in the official parade line-up sheet will not be permitted to enter the parade unless authorized by the CITY OF HAYDEN or its designated representative.
- 3. All parade participants shall refrain from any lewd or obscene gestures, language or signage during the parade.
- 4. Participants need to remain in the lane they are staged (even #'s in east lane, odd #'s in west lane) for the duration of the parade. This helps us keep the parade at a slower pace.
- 5. All parade participants will maintain a twenty (20)-foot separation between entries.
- 6. No fireworks or open flames are allowed to be used in the parade.
- 7. Use or possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal substance is forbidden.
- 8. Competitive entries in Divisions I–VI must be decorated in accordance with the parade theme.
- 9. Drivers of motorized vehicles must hold a valid driver's license to operate their assigned vehicles.
- 10. Parade participants must demonstrate proof of auto insurance if operating a motorized vehicle.
- 11. No discharge of a firearm or firearms is allowed.
- 12. Commercial signage is limited to that permanently affixed to the parade unit.
- 13. Disbanding at the end of the parade:
- a. WALKERS may disband at Honeysuckle Avenue.
- b. VEHICLES need to disband in the staging area between Honeysuckle & Nita Avenues and will be directed to their disbanding spot by parade staff.
- 14. The parade fee is non-refundable.
