What is Hayden's Impact on Law Enforcement?

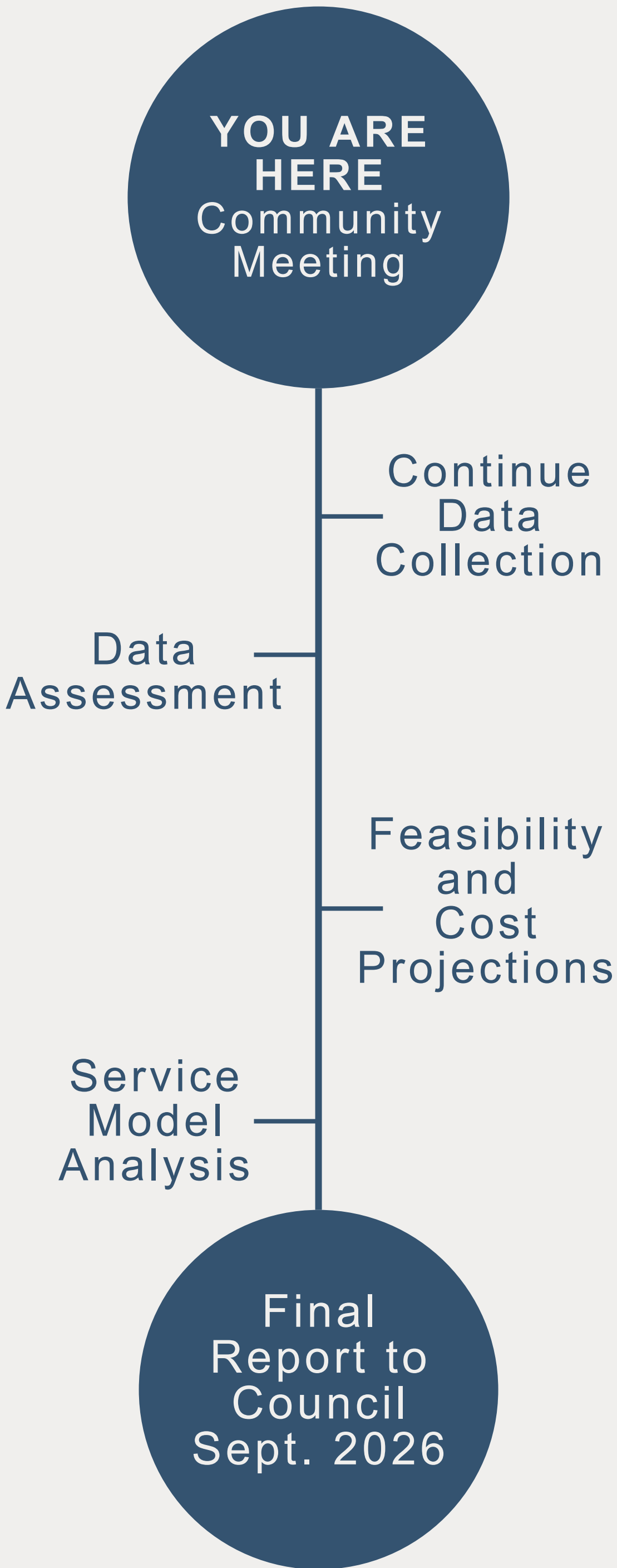
Hayden currently receives law enforcement services through a contract with the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, a model that has adapted over time as the community has grown and service needs have changed.

To understand how this affects current service demands, the City is conducting an independent study to guide future planning.

Set Service Levels

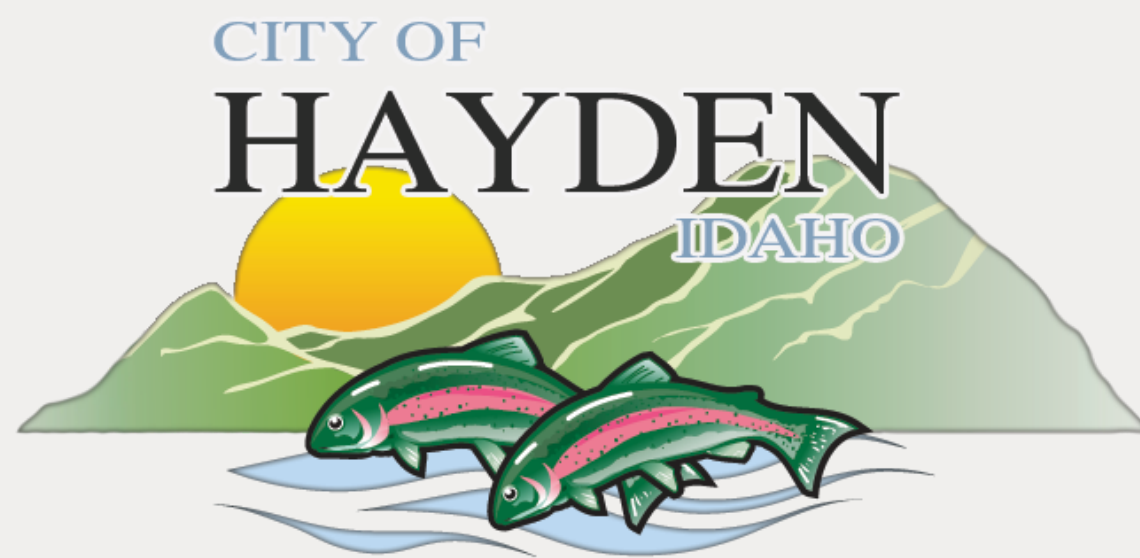
- Council determines the preferred level of law enforcement service.

- Staff develops budget options based on chosen service levels.

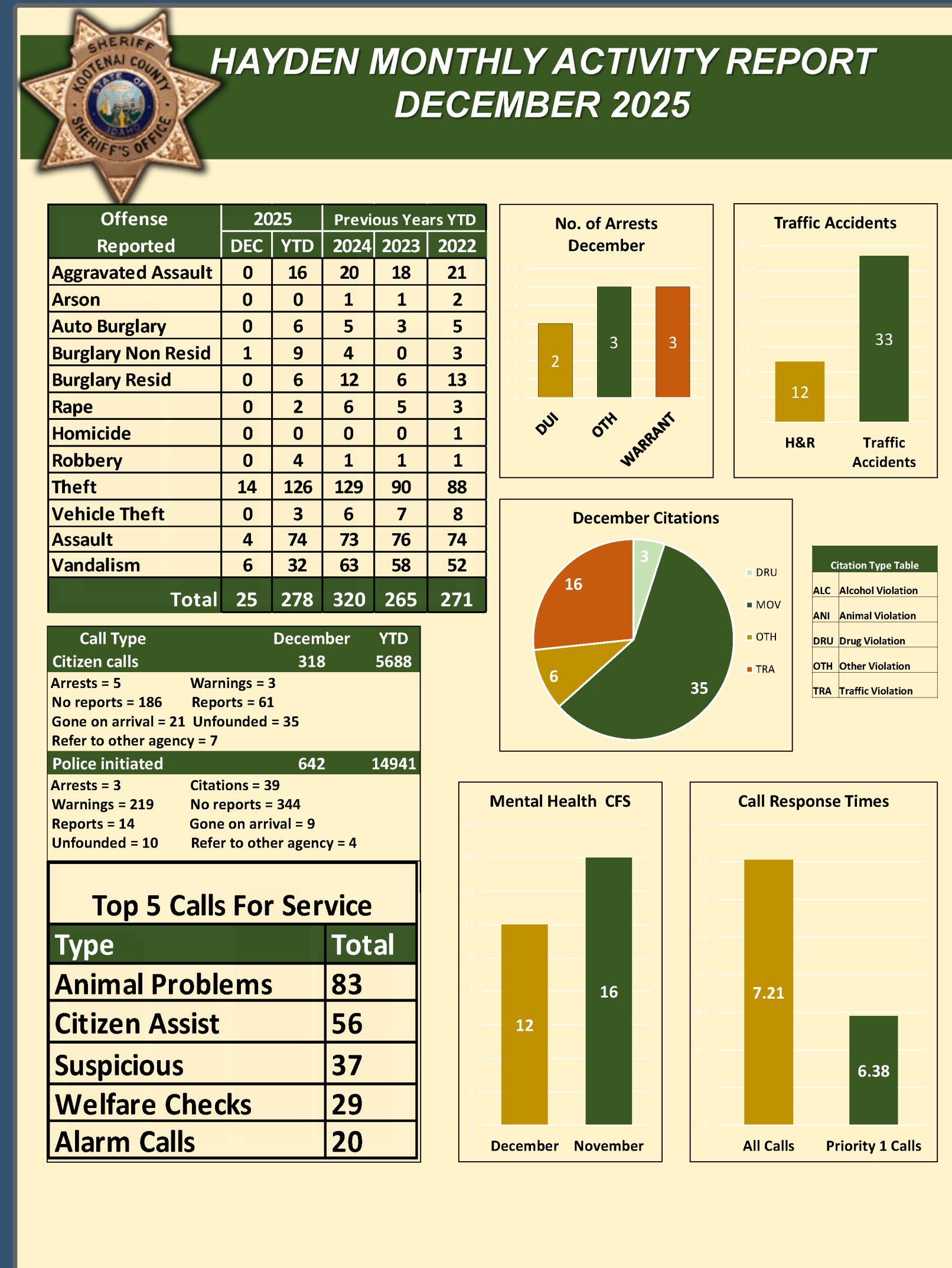
Implementation

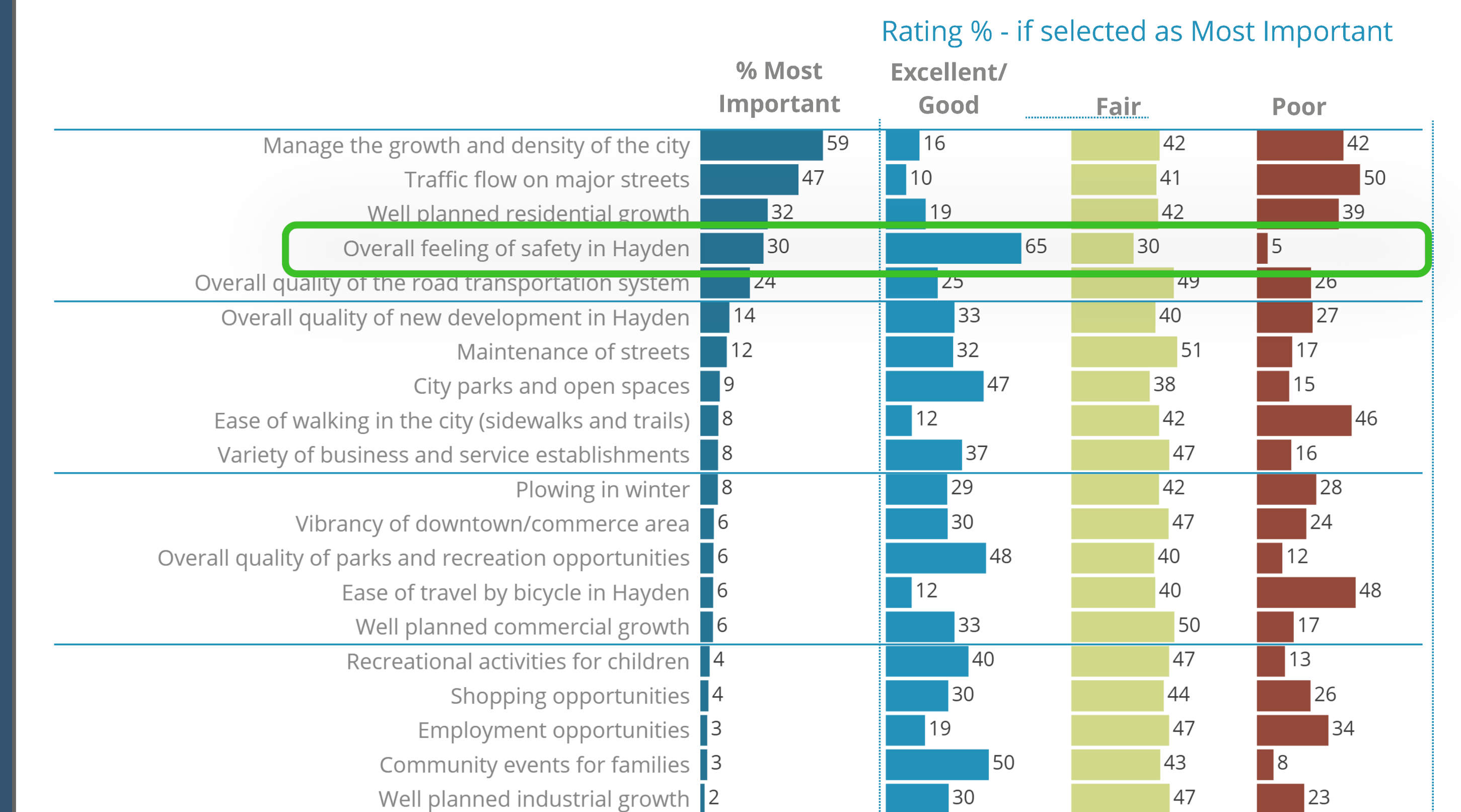

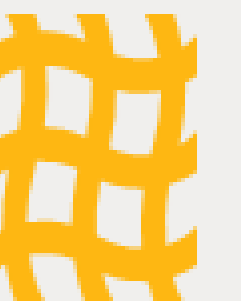
