- Approved the Consent Agenda:

 - c) Accepting the proposal submitted by Fox Environmental Services for technical support and compliance with GA EPD Stormwater Phase II Permit and MNGWPD requirements.
 - d) Authorizing the amendment of SPLOST funding for police vehicle, in the amount of \$21,551.00.
- Authorized replacement of the Heat/AC unit for Court Services by Ronald Smith Heating & Air, in the amount of \$6,311.00 plus a 10% contingency in the amount of \$631.00, to be funded by Public Works Capital Outlay.
