- Approved minutes from the June 7, 2022 Regular Session.
- Authorized paying \$10,747.60 out of Police SPLOST instead of using General Fund for purchase/outfitting of 2022 Police Interceptor.
- Authorized purchase of a Brush Chipper from Vermeer, in an amount not to exceed \$50,185.00, to be funded by Recreation SPLOST and Street SPLOST, split evenly, and apply insurance proceeds.
- Authorized replacement of the old playground at Ben Hill Strickland Sr. Memorial Park with a cement pad and pavilion, by Rhodes Contracting LLC and HWK Contracting, in the amount of \$128,404.00 plus an additional 10% contingency amount of \$12,840.00, to be funded by Recreation SPLOST.
- David Mooney thanked the Mayor and Council for the inclusive park. He expressed the need to focus on the youth in our community and he also requested that the gates to Gray's Mill Park be opened.
- Mayor and Council thanked staff for the success of Red White & Boom.
- Councilmember Bayardelle discussed Gray's Mill Park.
- Chief Turner stated the Department had another Narcan save. He also thanked Tyrone Griffin for the success of the Juneteenth parade and festival.
- Tyrone Griffin thanked the Mayor and Council and staff for their support of the Juneteenth parade and festival.
