- Approved the minutes from the February 1, 2022 Regular Session and the February 21, 2022 Work Session.
- Approved the Consent Agenda:
 - a) Authorizing sponsorship of Leadership Paulding 32's class project to help preserve the Hiram Rosenwald School & Museum in the amount of \$1,000.00, to be funded by Elected Officials Special Events/Sponsorships expenditure account.
 - b) Approving request from New Season Church to use Gray's Mill Park for Easter event on April 9, 2022.
 - c) Moving April Regular Session to April 12, 2022 at 6pm.
 - d) Approving FY22 mid-year budget amendments.
 - e) Approving Camp Hornet 2022 proposal as presented at the February 21, 2022 Work Session.
 - f) Authorizing the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Paulding County Department of Transportation to pave the City of Hiram's portion of Carrington Point Subdivision and Watts Road, in the amount of \$230,000.00, to be funded by Street SPLOST.
 - g) Authorizing repair of City Hall's roof by Raymond's Roofing, in an amount not to exceed \$11,200.00, to be funded by Public Works Capital Outlay.
 - h) Authorizing replacement of the HVAC unit on the Police Department side of City Hall by Dobbs Heating and Air, in an amount not to exceed \$5,206.00, to be funded by Public Works M&O.

- Council appointed Angela Hartsfield to the Board of Ethics.
- Mayor appointed John Moyses to the Board of Ethics and the Council approved the appointment.
- Amended the Hotel Motel Excise Tax Disbursement Agreement with Paulding County Chamber of Commerce to increase the disbursement amount set forth in Section 1 to 40% and to amend the expiration date set forth in Section 18 to June 30, 2022, in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 48-13-51.
- Set the date of the 2022 Red White & Boom Event as July 2, 2022.
- Approved Option 4 (GMA) for Health Insurance, as presented in the City of Hiram Employee Insurance Benefits Proposal, including adoption of Ordinance 2022-01 and the Participation Agreement, and renewal of all other benefits with NFP.
- Authorized installation of broadband fiber at Homer Leggett Memorial Park by Comcast, in an amount not to exceed \$18,975.00, to be funded by ARPA.
