

CITY OF HIRAM COUNCIL MEETING REGULAR SESSION SUMMARY MINUTES Tuesday, February 7, 2023

The Regular Session for February 7, 2023 was called to order by Mayor Frank Moran at 6:00pm in the Municipal Annex.

- Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance by Clifford McGrady.
- Chief Turner delayed the presentation of eight (8) Life-Saving Commendations to members of the Hiram Police Department until the next Regular Session.
- Hiram Hospitality League presented a review of their 2022 Events.
- Approved minutes from the January 3, 2023 Regular Session; January 26, 2023 Joint Board Meeting; and the January 31, 2023 Work Session.
- Approved the Consent Agenda:
 - Authorizing the replacement of the HVAC unit in the basement of the 76 Seaboard Street building by Ronald Smith Heating & Cooling, in an amount not to exceed \$7,615.00, to be funded by Public Works M&O.
 - Authorizing \$6,547.91 in additional funds for the upfitting of two police vehicles, to be funded by Police SPLOST.
 - Authorizing use of Gray's Mill Park the weekend of October 6 to October 9 for Faith & Blue Weekend.
- Tabled vote on Ordinance 2023-01, Rezoning of 1680 Hiram Douglasville Highway (Compass Storage) from B2 to I1, until the Regular Session on March 7, 2023.
- Approved the purchase the Ford F-150 that was stolen and then recovered from Gallagher Bassett for \$28,791.67, to be funded by Street SPLOST.
- Discussed the request from Boy Scouts Troop 7 to use 76 Seaboard Street as a pickup location for their pinestraw fundraiser on March 17 and 18.
- A Boy Scout representative answered questions pertaining to the cost of the pinestraw.
- Authorized Boy Scouts Troop 7 to use 76 Seaboard Street as a pickup for their pinestraw fundraiser on March 17 and 18, 2023.
- Mayor Moran mentioned upcoming news and events:
 - February 28: Work session at 6PM in Municipal Annex.
- Councilmember Bayardelle mentioned two upcoming events at the Hiram Rosenwald.
- A citizen voiced their opposition to the rezoning of 1680 Hiram Douglasville Highway (Compass Storage) from B2 to I1. Specifying that they would like the 1.2 acre parcel to remain zoned as B2.
- Adjourned the Regular Session.
