RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL TO SUBMIT AN FY22 LOCAL MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT GRANT APPLICATION TO THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation made available funding under the FY22 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, such funding may be used to fund transportation improvement projects such as adding turn lanes, milling and resurfacing, or repairing bridges; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation has allocated the City of Hiram \$43,966.76 for Fiscal Year 2022 through the program's funding allocation formula; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hiram must include an additional 30% match for the program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hiram desires to use this funding to complete storm water improvements, leveling, and resurfacing a paved roadway in the City; and

WHEREAS, evidence authorizing the acceptance of said application must be provided.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT SO RESOLVED, this 4th day of January, 2022, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hiram that the submission of the FY22 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant application is hereby approved; and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the necessary award package with directives under the Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant Program:
