**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-07**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIRAM, GEORGIA, TO FIX THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE OF THE CITY OF HIRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Charter of the City of Hiram, Georgia authorizes the City to levy and provide for the assessment of ad valorem property taxes on all property subject to taxation; and

**WHEREAS**, the valuation of all property subject to taxation by the City shall be determined according to the tax digest prepared by the Paulding County Board of Tax Assessors; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hiram, Georgia calculated a rollback millage rate as defined within State of Georgia law, demonstrating the proposed millage rate is less than the rollback millage rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has properly given notice with the publication of the 5-year history of levy in the legal organ, Dallas New Era, in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 48-5-32.1(c)(1); and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council have determined that the City of Hiram, Georgia should set a levy in the amount of 0.00 on each 1,000.00 of taxable value for all property subject to ad valorem taxation by the City;

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hiram, Georgia as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The ad valorem tax rate for the City of Hiram, Georgia for the 2024 fiscal year on property subject to ad valorem taxation by the City is hereby fixed at 0.00 on forty percent (40%) of each \$1,000.00 of property subject to ad valorem tax by the City.


**SECTION 2:** Said rate of 0.00 on forty percent (40%) of each \$1,000.00 of taxable property will yield no property taxes for General Government purposes.


**SECTION 3:** This Resolution will be effective immediately upon adoption by the Governing Authority on November 8, 2023.

**SECTION 4:** All Resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.


